Parents can expect the school to:

- provide a Christian atmosphere where your child can grow socially, spiritually and morally
- support your child to reach their full academic and personal potential
- provide a wide range of educational opportunities
- be a caring, loving, happy place for your child
- finish the school day on time (3.20pm)
- treat absence and lateness very seriously
- have a fair but firm Behaviour Policy, which promotes high standards of behaviour
- set appropriate homework
- give clear information on what is being taught, and how your child is achieving
- send regular letters giving details about school activities
- update the website regularly in order that it reflects current information.

- be set personal targets that improve my work
- be given clear instructions so that I know exactly what is going on.

School can expect children to:

- be caring and understanding of others
- be well behaved
- hand in homework on time, making sure it is neat and complete.

School can expect parents to:

- encourage and help your child to fulfil their academic and personal potential
- support the school in providing a range of educational opportunities
- be aware of the Church of England foundation and respect the Christian principles of the school
- ensure that your child arrives at school on time (8.45am)
- ensure that your child attends every day and absences and lateness are explained as soon as possible
- make sure that your child is prepared for school, (e.g. having had enough sleep, breakfast and is properly equipped)
- be aware and supportive of the Behaviour Policy
- help and support your child with their homework, especially reading (every day) and learning spellings and times tables
- give relevant information about your child's well-being that might affect work or behaviour
- attend the parents' evening each term
- support, where possible, events and activities organised by the Friends of the School.
