INFANT CHRISTMAS PRODUCTION

As you are aware the Infants will be holding their production 'Prickly Hay' in the School Hall at 2 pm on Tuesday, 6 December and 9.30 am on Wednesday, 7 December.



Admission to these performances will be by ticket only due to restriction of space. Tickets will be available free from the infant playground before school on Tuesday, 29 November, Wednesday, 30 November and Thursday, 1 December. If raining they will be in the Activity Room (the room at the top of the ramp near the Reception Classroom door). Tickets will not be available after these dates.

Tickets will be restricted initially to two per family. A reserve list for extra tickets will be available on Friday and extra tickets will be given to your child on Friday, 2 December if they are available.

It would be helpful if you did not bring babies or pre-school children to the performances and, therefore, we will be offering a crèche facility at both performances. When you collect your tickets please let us know if you will require a place at the crèche.

The Junior performance - 'Silent Night' will take place at Christ Church Church on Thursday, 8 December at 2.00 p.m. and Friday, 9 December at 10.00 a.m. There is no need for us to offer tickets for these productions as there is sufficient room in the Church.
