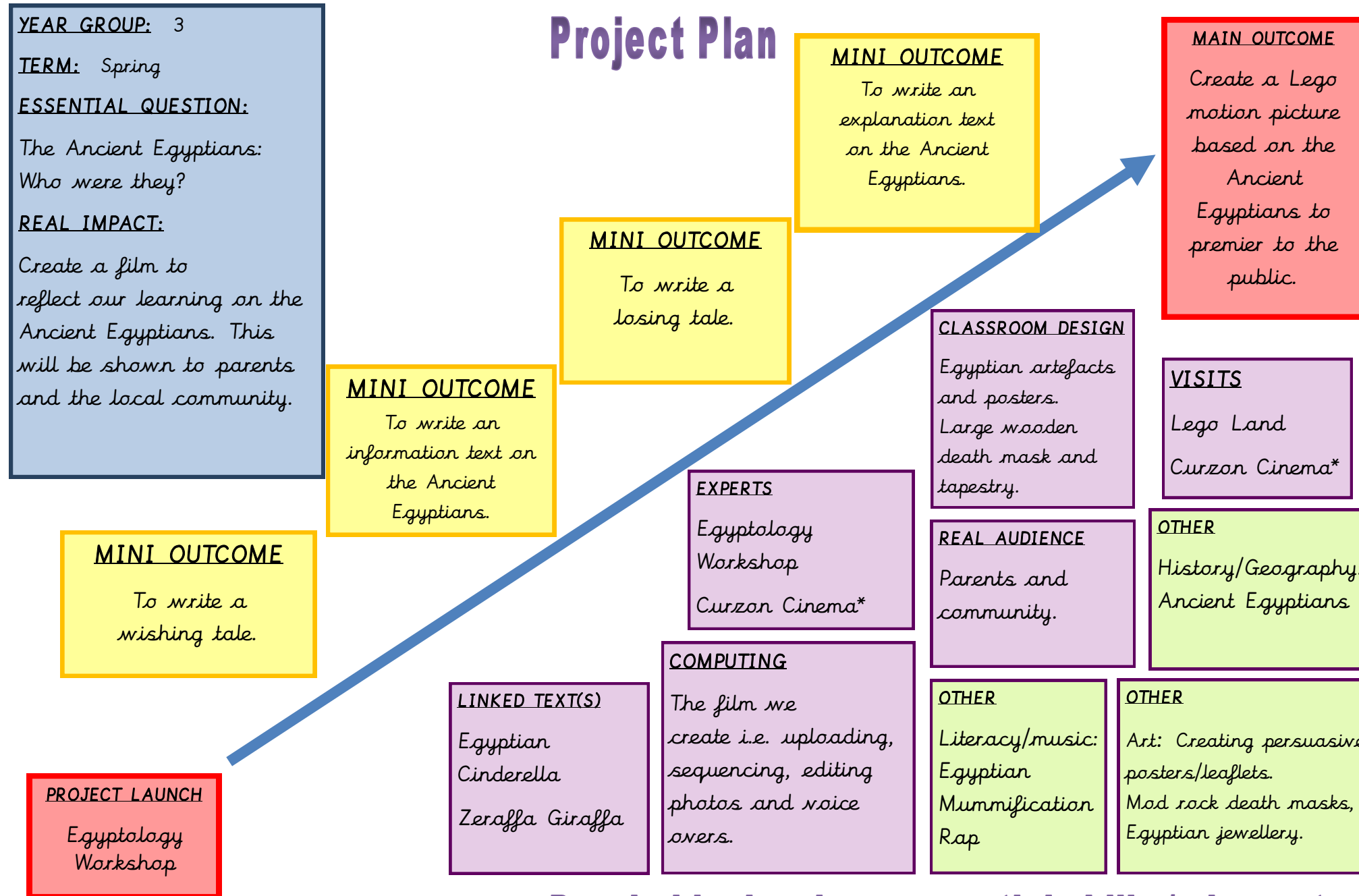


Project Plan



Purple blocks show essential skills / elements.

Numeracy:
 Children will have weekly Mental Maths and Multiplication tests as well as covering the following areas during the two terms:
 MMD - Mental multiplication and division.
 WMD - Written multiplication and division.
 MEA - Measurement (money)
 STA - Statistics
 MEA - Measurement (length and perimeter)
 FRA - Fractions
 PRA - Problem solving, reasoning and algebra
 You can help your child by practising their times tables and calculation methods at

Literacy:
 During literacy this term we will be reading: 'Egyptian Cinderella' and 'Zeraffa Giraffa'.
 Using these texts the children will be writing: their own stories; a play-script; a story board; an information text; a discussion text, a non-chronological report and a rap.
 Children will have weekly guided reading sessions to help with their comprehension and weekly spelling tests.
 To help your child at home please could you read with them every night and support them in practising their spellings.



MAIN OUTCOME
 Create a Lego motion picture based on the Ancient Egyptians to premier to the public.

Science:
 This term we will be exploring light and the human body. We will investigate the sun and how shadows are formed. We will also look at how our bodies are made and what nutrition we need to stay fit and healthy.

Music
 This term we will be following the Charanga music scheme. Learning to play the Glockenspiel and Recorder.

Geography
 The main focus this term will be Egypt. Within this topic we will be focusing on the location, its most interesting landmarks, and how/why they are there.

ART and DT
 This term we will be designing and making Egyptian masks and jewellery out of mod rock. We will also be exploring how the Egyptians used Hieroglyphics.

MFL: French
 This term the children will be learning how to hold a basic conversation in French and the names for body parts, classroom objects and animals.

Computing
 In computing this term we will be using Scratch to programme our sprites to carry out movements. We will also learn how to use Windows Movie Maker to make a Lego motion picture using digital photographs and recorded voiceovers.

 Every Wednesday morning the children will have swimming lessons at Hutton Moor and Weston Football Club will be taking the children for PE.
