



What are Personal Details?

What information should you give to someone you don't know?

Which of the following would you share with a stranger?

Who is a stranger?

These are people who your family do not know, people you have not met or know little about.

Online friends are still strangers even if you have been talking to them for a long time.

Remember if you are not sure about something **ASK** or **TELL AN ADULT**

Remember if someone asks you
something you are not sure about
TELL AN ADULT

**Home
telephone
number**

This is personal information and should only be given to people you know and trust. True friends would never share or misuse your number.

Your home number is the property of your parents so
ALWAYS ASK THEIR PERMISSION FIRST.

This information can be sold or given to other who may then contact you.

Remember if you are asked something you are not sure about **FIRST ASK AN ADULT**

**My date
of birth**

Although this information is personal, it is often asked for by websites.

It lets people know if you are the appropriate age. Not giving the correct information could put you at risk of being lead to somewhere you are not sure about.

BUT

This information can put you at risk.

So is it important for you to register on this site?

If a **PERSON** you do not know asks this question you should remember you do not know who they are!

Remember if you are asked something you are not sure about **FIRST ASK AN ADULT**

Hair colour

Although this is personal information telling someone will only put you at risk if you knowingly arrange to meet the person.

Think; this could help the person identify you without you knowing, do they need to know?

Remember if you are asked something you are not sure you should tell,
FIRST ASK AN ADULT

Diary

This is personal information and you should never share this with anyone you do not want to.

Be careful when sharing plans about future events. You never know what someone may do with the information.

Remember if you are asked for information you are not happy to give someone

FIRST ASK AN ADULT

Toothbrush

Ugh
NO WAY

Remember if you are asked for
something you are not sure about
FIRST ASK AN ADULT

**Names of
my pets**

It is good to share some information
with new friends.

Giving someone you don't know this
information is fine, it is good to have
something to talk about that is not too
personal.

Remember if someone asks you
questions you are not sure about
TELL AN ADULT

**Photo of
your family**

It is good fun to share photos with your friends but do you know everyone who will be looking at them?, would your friend show anyone else?

Giving someone access to your photos can lead to problems it would be best to show your friends when you next see them.

Once a photo is placed on the internet it may become difficult to protect it. Remember you may not be the only person in the photo and do you have the other peoples' permission!

Using a generic image is advisable.

Remember if someone asks you to upload an image of yourself or others

FIRST TELL AN ADULT

School
jumper

This is your personal property and it is your choice what happens to it.

It is good to help out a friend.

If they need your jumper there is no reason why you would not share it with them. You know your friend will always look after your things, treat them with respect and return them to you.

Remember if someone wants something from you are not sure about

FIRST ASK AN ADULT

**Pin number
for a parent's
bank card**

This is **SOMEONE ELSE'S**
personal information that
MUST NEVER
be given to anyone!

You must always keep security numbers
and passwords safe.

Remember if anyone ask you for
security details you
MUST TELL AN ADULT

**Home
address**

This is personal information and should only be given to people you know and trust. True friends would never share or misuse your address.

This information can be sold on to other companies who will then send you junk mail.

Never give out your home address, use a wider location instead i.e. Somerset.

Remember if you are asked for personal information **FIRST ASK AN ADULT**

Favourite food

It is good to share views and listen to others.

Giving someone you don't know this information is fine, you never know they may tell you about something you may like to try.

Remember if something happens you are not sure about
TELL AN ADULT

You must always protect your
personal information.

BUT REMEMBER

You must protect others' information as
if it was your own. When friends share
their personal information with you, they
are trusting you to keep it to yourself and
not to pass it on.

Your personal details are only as safe as the
people you trust them with.

**SO IF YOU DON'T TRUST THEM THEN
DON'T TELL THEM!**
